How Habitat for Humanity Works

- Through volunteer labor and tax-deductible donations of money and materials, Habitat for Humanity builds and rehabilitates simple, decent housing with the help of partner-homeowner families.
- Habitat houses are sold to partner families at no profit, financed with affordable, no-interest loans.
- The homeowners' monthly mortgage payments are recycled into a revolving Fund for Humanity to build more houses.
- Homeowners invest hundreds of hours of their own labor into building their Habitat house and the houses of others.

How Families Qualify

Partner/Homeowner families must meet three requirements to be considered for a Habitat home:

- Their present housing is inadequate, unsafe or substandard.
- Although unable to qualify for a standard mortgage, they can consistently meet Habitat's low, zero-interest mortgage payments, while managing their other finances.
- Family members can work in partnership with Habitat and invest "sweat equity" hours in their home: 300 hours for a single-parent household and 500 hours for a dual-parent household.

Building Hope With Habitat for Humanity

Of course, you're not limited to just one square foot. You can donate as many square feet or rooms as your budget allows.
